The Bloomington Housing Authority is excited to announce that we are partnering with the U.S. Census Bureau to support the 2020 Census. As a partner, we will be working to make sure our community is accurately represented in the upcoming decennial count.

We especially encourage **public housing residents** and **Section 8 voucher-holders** to respond to letters or follow-up visits from the US Census Bureau later this year. **Your response matters!** Census results are the basis for congressional representation and help determine how more than \$675 billion in federal funds is distributed each year to support vital programs (including health care, housing, and education) in states and communities across the country.

Beginning in mid-March 2020, residents can respond to the census online, by phone, or by mail. **Residents should count everyone living or staying in their home, including newborn babies and young children, even if they aren't related to you or are only staying with you temporarily.**

No matter how you respond, your personal information is confidential, is protected by law, and can never be used to identify you. Public housing residents and Section 8 voucher-holders should know that **information you report to the Census can never be shared with law enforcement agencies or with BHA's management.** Learn more at [2020CENSUS.GOV](https://2020census.gov).
