Subject: Request for Quote to install network cable with conduit underground

Quote for:

The Housing Authority of the City of Bloomington invites quotes from properly qualified professional firms to install approximately 210' of underground conduit with network cable on property owned and operated by the Housing Authority of the City of Bloomington. All prospective Offerors need to be licensed and insured. The pricing shall reflect all labor, material, and associated costs. The contractor who is awarded the contract shall furnish the following items: Non-Conclusive Affidavit, Proof of Insurance, and payroll reports. Other documentation forms required will be included with the Contract Documents. Davis Bacon wage rates will be required for the project. All quotes will be valid for up to one year from the quote's date. The Scope of Work and Bid form is provided with this Request for Quote.

Quotes will be held in confidence and not released in any manner until after contract award. After evaluation of Quotes and revisions, if any, the contract shall be awarded to the responsible firm whose qualifications, price, and other factors considered, are the most advantageous to the Housing Authority.

Scope of Work

Install approximately 210' of category 6 ethernet cable (OR fiber optic cable) in underground conduit between the two buildings that comprise the Irvin Apartments, 810 W. Jackson and 823 W. Oakland Avenue. The ethernet/fiber optic cable will provide a network connection between the two buildings. The installation will run from the west wall of the utility room of each building, which is where existing modem and routers are situated (see attached floorplan sketch).

Bid should be divided in two costs:

Bid #1: Underground conduit with including **Fiber Optic cable**.

Bid #2: Underground conduit with including **Category 6 ethernet cable**.

General Scope:

- Demolition:
 - Dig ground to prepare installations of underground approved conduit

- Installation:
 - Provide all labor, material, and equipment to install contracted underground approved conduit.
 - Set at depth per any applicable city code. Minimum 10" below surface.
 - Install hard conduit through brick wall into both utility rooms
 - Install Bid selected network cable leaving 10' length of cable on both ends coiled up for later connections
 - All protrusions to be weather sealed

- Phasing:
 - Contractor is to provide a phasing plan that will minimize the impact to occupied areas
 - Contractor is required to provide two weeks' notice for any floor replacement in contracted area.

- Code Requirements:
 - The installed system must, at a minimum, be in accordance with all applicable codes.

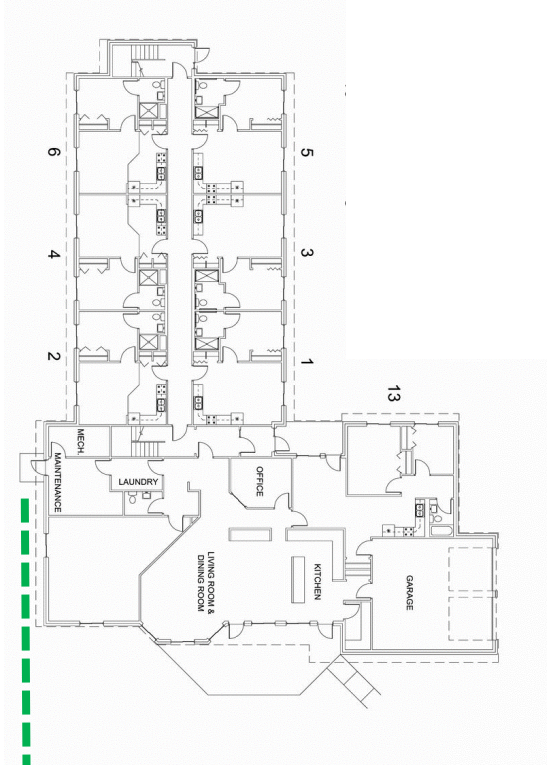

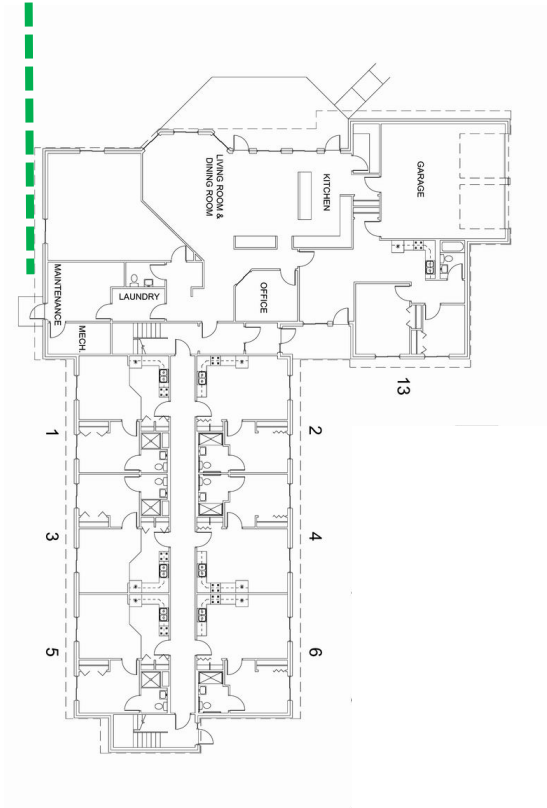
